

# Stay protected. Get boosted.



The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has issued updated guidance for who can get a second booster dose of an mRNA COVID-19 vaccine. We are updating our systems and processes so we can administer second booster doses according to this guidance.

The guidance includes the following groups who received their first booster dose at least 4 months ago:

- People 50 and older
- People 12 and older who are moderately to severely immunocompromised
- People 18 to 49 who received the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine and first booster dose
